recently began attending Lewisville, after moving to Moncton from Ontario. They met while Kara was attending Redeemer University and Bryan was raising support for Athletes in Action. Originally a Maritimer (she's from Truro!), Kara moved to Ontario to pursue a job

—translation: she wanted to be closer to Bryan! The couple was married in September 2010. In August 2012, Bryan was offered the position of Athletics Director at Crandall University, and Kara joined him in Moncton soon after.

Through Bryan's position as Athletics Director, he has the opportunity to work with students to participate in the Athletes in Action National Training Camp. Below, Bryan explains in his own words the importance of this opportunity, and how you can help!

*I believe strongly in the relationship between faith and sport. I am excited about the growth I have witnessed in athletes and in the athletic programs on our campus. I believe athletes from Crandall can be competitive in their sport while having an impact through their lives for God. I wanted to share with you a tremendous opportunity to partner with 5 athletes from our University at the Athletes in Action, National Training Camp (NTC) in Ottawa on May 5-10, 2013.*

*Chargers athletics is seeking local funds in the amount of \$5,000 to be able to send Christian athletes to National Training Camp for a life changing experience. We are hoping you will prayerfully consider sponsoring one of our athletes (\$1000 per athlete) for this event or making a gift that will enable one or more of them to participate.*

*Five key students will be chosen who:*

- are in year 2-3 of study
- stand out both as Christian leaders and athletic leaders on their team
- exemplify what it means to be a student athlete at Crandall University

*Each athlete chosen will write a summary of the principles learned at NTC for circulation upon return.*

*What is the National Training Camp?*

*Since 1988, the NTC has been gathering athletes together to challenge them to raise their level of faith on and off the field. The Camp is designed with athletes in mind and combines in-class instruction with athletic competition. The camp challenges every participant to see themselves and every competition through the lens of God. The camp ends with the "ultimate" test...a 24-hour multi-sport marathon known as the S.P.E.C.I.A.L.*

*Each of the chosen Crandall athletes will be in for a life-changing experience at the National Training Camp as they connect with great people and staff from across Canada. They will join hundreds of other athletes who have seen NTC impact their lives and sport in a profound way.*
